MOLLY HARVEY, the Soul Woman was born in County Waterford, Southern Ireland, the eldest of three children.

She was brought up on a 2,700 acre estate owned by Lord (de la Poer) Beresford, 8th Marquis of Waterford.

Her father worked with the horses and, if still alive today, would be known as a 'horse whisperer'.

The Soul Woman was born intuitive, but she didn't recognise her own talent - until the age of thirteen, she thought everyone could sense another person's soul, but she was discouraged from using her special gifts and advised to put them away. This caused her to withdraw into herself and close the door on her true calling in life.

Then in 1998 a chance encounter changed her life. A businessman she had known for many years, visited her home in England and told her that she was a healer. She slowly began to realise that what she calls "her wilderness years" were over and started to re-open the door to the gifts she had been given.

Molly was the visionary and founder of the world's first ever soul school which she launched in Minnesota, USA in 2006. The soul school was Molly's way of giving something back, a chance to open doors in other people's lives.

America was a phenomenal success, so Molly decided to bring the soul school experience closer to home:

"I have always known that one day I would bring people from all over the world back to the magical land of the fairies and mystics where I grew up," says Molly. "Waterford 2007 was quite simply the highlight of my life."

But the inspirational Irishwoman with the storytelling charm isn't resting yet. Following the success in Waterford, she now plans to extend the experience to England, and will open her first soul school there next year.

The Soul Woman has dedicated the last twenty years of her life to mentoring and teaching people in organisations – quite a turnaround for a woman who daydreamed her way through school, only discovering her deep passion for learning in young adulthood.

Molly Harvey has been described as someone who can 'help people do what most of us can only imagine'. In a nutshell, she can help people visualise.

Today, she is President of the Institute for Science and Spirituality and a Fellow of the Professional Speakers Association.

But without doubt, the pinnacle of her speaking career to date was the moment she addressed the world's young leaders conference at the United Nations in New York in March 2006 – this amazing woman was able to use her influence on the world stage to inspire the next generation.
